



ODISHA STATE COMPUTING OLYMPIAD (FOR CLASSES X, XI & XII)

Of late, India has been producing young computing millionaires at a fast pace, who have believed in innovation and entrepreneurship at a young age and have come forward to form their home start-ups which have eventually grown to become million dollar companies.

Keeping in view the new thrust of the "Start-Up-India" campaign and Government of Odisha's start-up policy, there has been a need to identify bright minds with mathematical and computing potentials who can be trained on the cutting-edge computing technologies free of cost to motivate them to build on their talents within the ecosystem of innovation and start-up in the field of computing.

ODISHA STATE COMPUTING OLYMPIAD (OSCO) is an attempt in this direction and is being organized under the mentorship of Computer Society of India (CSI) Bhubaneswar Chapter, with participation of Trident Academy of Technology under the IPS (Innovation Promotion Scheme) of AICTE, Govt of India.

There will be separate offline MCQ(Multiple Choice Questions) tests in interested schools involving students of Class-X, XI and XII (Separate questions for each class and standardised but different sets for each school).

The Principals / Headmasters of interested schools/Junior colleges are requested to contact the undersigned through mails or phone to take part in the Olympiad, which will be conducted between 10th and 20th of December 2016. For both mathematics and computing, there will be preliminary rounds in the respective schools and the venue for the state final will be informed to the short-listed students who will clear the minimum cut-off.

Apart from attractive prizes, the students will have free-of-cost trainings to be conducted through a summer camp on advanced computing technologies for school level, during April / May 2017.
