In 2024, students of Trident Academy of Technology benefited from both government and institutional scholarship schemes. Here's a summary:

- **Post-Matric Scholarship (Odisha):**
 - 513 students benefited from the government scheme, receiving ₹10,071,300.
 - 291 students benefited from the institution's scheme, receiving ₹3,820,000.
- **e-Medhabruti Technical & Professional (Odisha):**
 - 383 students benefited from the government scheme, receiving ₹5,160,000.
- **National Scholarships:**
 - **AICTE:** 28 students received ₹1,150,000.
 - **Prime Minister's Scholarship:** 4 students received ₹128,000.
 - **Ministry of Higher Education:** 2 students received ₹40,000.
- **Post-Matric Scholarship (Jharkhand):**
 - 40 students received ₹34,00,000.

 - 32 students received ₹2,784,000.

Overall, **970 students** were supported through government schemes, receiving a total of ₹1,65,49,300.
