##### **Description:**

1. Trident Academy of Technology has a well-defined admission procedure
2. Trident Academy of Technology has an Admission Reservation Policy for underrepresented in place
3. Trident Academy of Technology gives relaxation of 5% in the eligibility criteria of all courses for students belonging to SC/ST and OBC (Non creamy layer) category as well as for People with disability (PWD) and Kashmiri migrants.
4. Trident Academy of Technology has scholarship programme for SC/ST/minority, and physically challenged students

For the 2024-25 admissions at Trident Academy of Technology, vertical and horizontal reservation quotas are implemented according to state guidelines.

Vertical quotas include 16.25% for Scheduled Castes (SC), 22.5% for Scheduled Tribes (ST), 11.25% for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), and 10% for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS).

Horizontal reservations are applied across these categories, with allocations for government school students (15%), persons with disabilities (5%), children of ex-servicemen and martyrs (5%), Jammu & Kashmir migrants (1-2%), and sportspersons (2-5%).

Reserved categories enjoy certain relaxations: EWS and SEBC candidates can receive up to a 5% mark relaxation, persons with disabilities (PWD) receive accommodations like scribes and extra exam time, and ex-servicemen's children have relaxed qualifying criteria. Jammu & Kashmir migrants are granted flexible document verification.

In the 2023-24 admissions, seat allocation data is as follows:

- **B.Tech:** 620seats (449 filled: 342GE, 61 OBC, 26 SC, 20 ST)
- **M.Tech:** 18 seats (25 filled: 11 GE, 8 OBC,3 each SC, ST)
- **MBA:** 60 seats (38 filled: 28 GE, 4 OBC, 3 each SC and ST)
- **MCA:** 60 seats (all filled: 56 GE, 42 OBC 10, SC, 2 ST 2)
